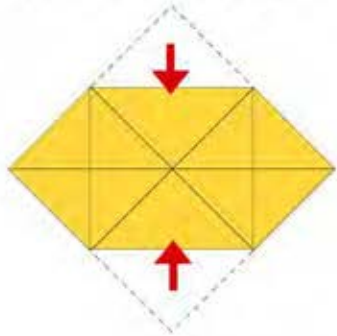

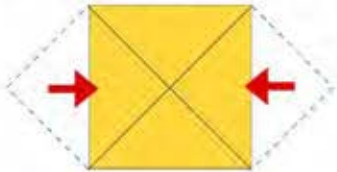
MAKE YOUR OWN FORTUNE TELLER

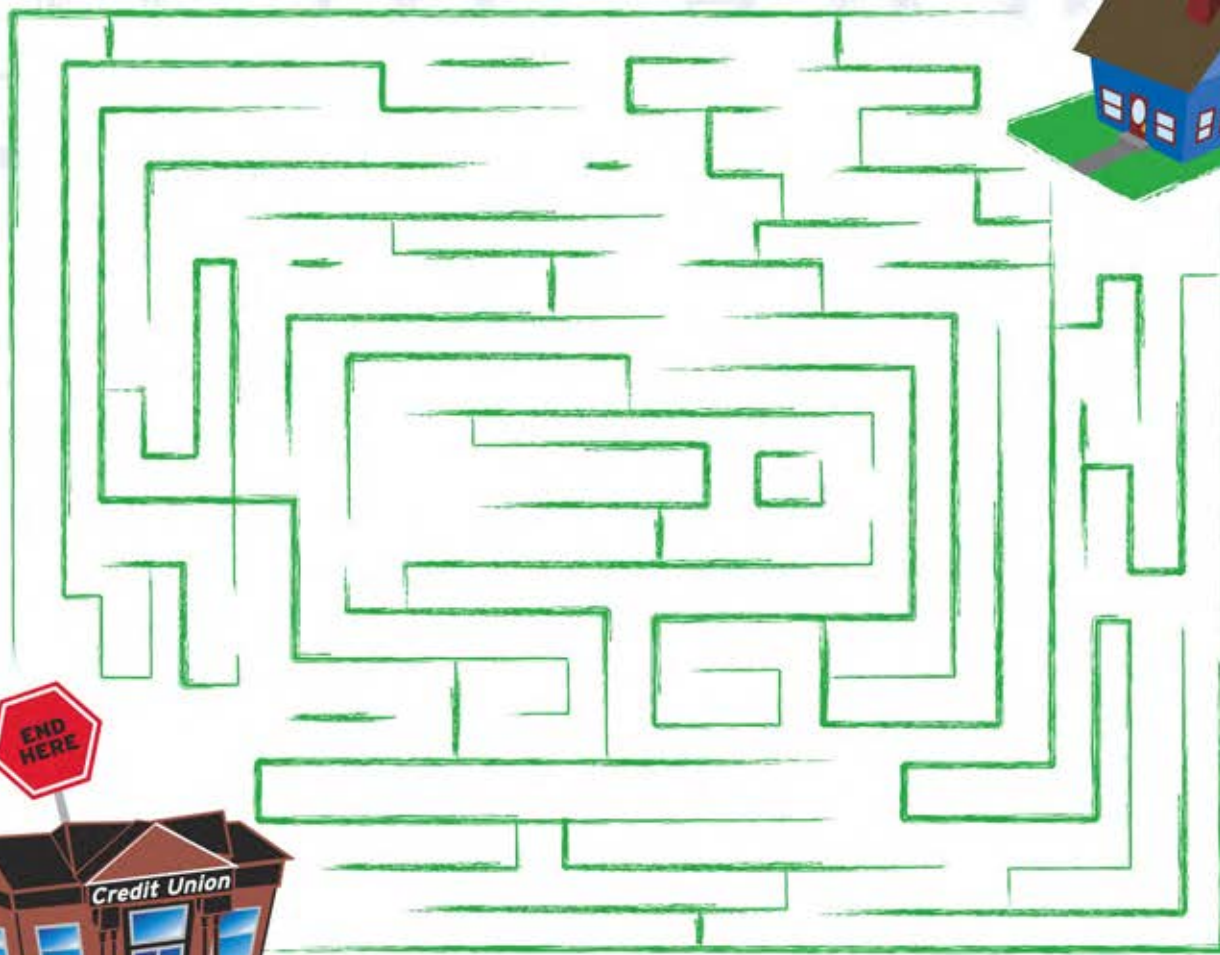
